

Requirements to Earn a Pine View Diploma

Pine View course requirements (26 credits)

Beginning SY 20/21, core academic courses, including English, Math, Science, Social Studies and World Language, must be taken on campus from gifted-endorsed faculty.

Rigorous Course Requirements

A total of 8 rigorous courses must be successfully completed beginning with freshman entering SY 20/21, class of 2024.

Rigorous courses include: Advanced Placement, Dual Enrollment, Statistics II Honors, Chemistry II Honors and Biology Technology.

Rigorous courses also include: Introduction to Engineering Design, Robotics, Aerospace Engineering, Design and Development and Digital Media (years 3 & 4).

Students must earn a grade of A, B or C in these courses. Students enrolled in AP courses must sit for the exam.

Additional Academic Requirements

Students must maintain unweighted 2.5 GPA core academic courses, including World Language courses, as determined by the 3 most recent grading periods.

Students must have the correct number of credits according to the Sarasota Student Progression Plan to be promoted.

Students transitioning to Pine View after 9th Grade

Credits earned prior to enrolling at Pine View may be accepted upon transcript review; however, students enrolling as a:

10th grader must earn 17 credits on the PV campus by gifted endorsed faculty to earn a PV Diploma.

11th grader must earn 11 credits on the PV campus by gifted endorsed faculty to earn a PV Diploma.

12th grader must earn 5 credits on the PV campus by gifted endorsed faculty to earn a PV Diploma.
